## TRAIL SAFETY

- Stay on the trails for your safety.
- Drink plenty of water.
- Be aware of wildlife; this is their home.
- Use the buddy system.

## RULES

- The Park is open sunrise to sunset.
- No motorized vehicles allowed.
- Firearms, fireworks, alcoholic beverages and glass containers are prohibited.
- Dogs are welcome as long as they stay on a leash.
- No hunting per Plaquemines Parish Ord. #12-37.
- Pet owner must remove pet waste from trail.
- All plants and animals are protected; do not harass wildlife or damage or remove plants.
- Stay on the trails for your safety.
- Tours for hire are allowed only with prior approval from Woodlands Conservancy.
- Leave no Trace – carry out what you carry in.
- Fund raising events or structured group activities must receive prior authorization from Woodlands Conservancy
- Authorization for camping and/or campfires must be obtained from Plaquemines Parish Government.
