

# **Woodlands Trail**

Woodlands Conservancy was organized in 2001 as a 501 (c) (3) nonprofit land trust to preserve forested wetlands and other lands of ecological or historical significance in Louisiana.

Woodlands Trail is located within 650 acres of forested wetlands. The forest provides habitat for thousands of resident and migratory birds and other native wildlife. It serves as a natural sponge to absorb water and as a windbreak during storm events.

#### **Trail Rules**

### **Trail Safety**

- Stay on the designated trails.
- Be aware of wildlife. This is their home.
- Drink plenty of water.
- Use the buddy system.
- Keep dogs on a 6-foot leash (maximum) in all areas, at all times.

#### Rules

- The trails are open from dawn to dusk
- Trails can be used for hiking, running, horseback riding.
- No motorized vehicles.
- Hikers yield to equestrians.
- Keep right, pass left.
- Approach and cross bridges and culverts with caution.
- Pack it in, pack it out.
- Pet owners must pick up and remove pet waste from the trail property.
- All plants and animals are protected; do not harrass or feed wildlife.
